1. Animal Safety

Animals are a loved part of farming, but they can also be dangerous and protective of their young. Always have a parent or adult with you if you want to get close to any farm animals.

2. Machinery Safety

Farms can be exciting places for kids to explore, but it's important to learn about how to be safe around machinery. Make safe play spaces on the farm, never play in or around farm equipment like tractors, combines, trucks, etc. whether they are running or not. Farm equipment can be very big and loud, and the driver may not be able to see or hear you if you are nearby.

3. Grain Safety

You can sink into grain and get trapped, so never climb or play in grain bins, grain trucks, grain carts or piles of grain.

4. Sun Safety

UV rays from the sun can harm your eyes and skin. When you're in the sun always wear a hat, sunglasses and apply sunscreen throughout the day.
